NEW ELIGIBILITY FOR ROM AWARD**

As at 1st August 2012, the revised and updated Rules for ROM and WAE Programme came into effect.

The ROM handbook had been long overdue for not only a reprinting but for a complete overhaul and update to encompass local amendments and overseas developments. One of the changes was to bring our programme more into line with that of the DPCA in for one, the recognition of additional performance titles. There was a need to recognise the achievements of our Dobermanns in disciplines other than traditional obedience and as a guide the levels which were acceptable to the D.P.C.A. were used.

In respect of Tracking and Agility these were T.D. and A.D. Accordingly any dog which obtained either a T.D. or A.D. title prior to 1st August 2012 and has gained its Champion title and a WAC is now eligible for the ROM award.

Any such applications will be considered and should be lodged by  
28<sup>th</sup> February 2013.

No applications will be considered for posthumous awards.
